Universal Design principles are design elements that make a room, home or building easily accessible for people of all ages and physical capabilities. A few of the most common examples of Universal Design are:

- Creating ground level, barrier free entrances without stairs
- Installing wide interior doors, and hallways
- · Providing clearances to approach and use fixtures like sinks or toilets
- Installing lever handles for opening doors rather than twisting knobs

The Contractor of the Year (CotY) award is given each year by the BucksMont chapter of the National Association of the Remodeling Industry (NARI) to members who have demonstrated outstanding work through their remodeling projects. NARI is a professional association whose members voluntarily subscribe to a strict code of ethics. To be considered for a CotY Award, a company must be a NARI member in good standing. Patricia Nunan, CKBR, CKD, CAPS, an Independent Living Consultant and designer, is president of Lifestyles Design.
